A transportation project in which at least one phase of project development is managed by a local government agency for which it is being reimbursed with federal or state funding.

Phases

- Environmental
- Design
- Right of Way acquisition
- Utility Relocation
- Construction

<u>TxDOT maintains oversight responsibility for all activities performed by the local</u> government.

Project Development Process

Project Identification Form

- Identify Project Sponsor/ Local Government (LG)
 - Entity name, Address, Unique Entity ID (UEID), etc.
 - Contact Person
- Project Details
 - Description, location, scope of work, estimated letting date, estimated cost,

- Oversight Level Special Approval Form,
 - Part A- LG Qualifications Statement (completed by Local Government)
 - Describe local government's approach to managing selected project
 - Details previous experience managing projects
 - Assign Project Manager, Responsible Person in Charge, and Qualified Person
 - Part B- TxDOT Evaluation and Special Approval of LG Qualifications (completed by TxDOT)
 - Risk Score will be determined

- TxDOT Contract Specialist will draft AFA and submit to LG for comment/review
- After concurrence from LG, AFA is submitted to Contract Services Division for review
- LG must pass a resolution, ordinance or commissioners court order
 - Identify the project
 - Identify funding source
 - Not mention specific project cost
 - Explicitly authorize the LG to enter into the AFA
 - Identify the authorized signatory
- TxDOT will arrange for electronic signature of AFA via DocuSign

The City Manager is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

Local Government Projects Procedures Training

- Training must be completed before federal funding is authorized
- At least one individual working actively and directly on the project must be certified
- State may deny reimbursement if training requirements are not met

- A Federal Project Authorization and Agreement (FPAA) must issued for all federally funded projects
 - Expenses incurred prior to issuance of FPAA are not eligible for reimbursement

 - 23 CFR Part 172
 - Texas Government Code Subchapter 2254.A

Project Accounting

- LG personnel responsible for keeping accurate financial records and documentation
- LG will make advance payments to TxDOT to cover Direct State Costs
- After project completion, TxDOT will coordinate a project reconciliation according to the terms of the agreement
- If LG withdraws from project, the LG will be responsible for any expenses incurred
