- Please **DO NOT** include unrelated bicycle/pedestrian facilities (i.e. from other existing or future projects) in the Google Map, as this map will be used to analyze the proposed project area.
- The Map name must include the applicant's name, project sponsor (if applicable) & the project name
- Map must be **publicly accessible on the web**.
- Map must feature a **line** showing the projects complete route.
- The map may also include line(s) and/or points of reference to the project's major construction elements, such as proposed bridges or signals.

Note: A Google Account is required to create or view My Maps.
